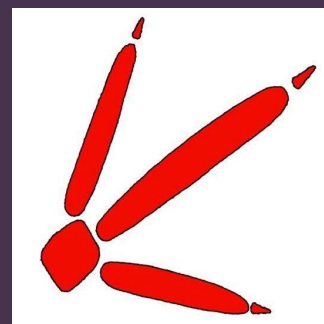


STUDENT GRAND ROUNDS



Please join us! The medical students of the UDRH from across NSW (Wollongong, Sydney, Adelaide) are coming together to host **student grand rounds** – an educational experience centered around case-based learning right here in Broken Hill.



WHAT IS STUDENT GRAND ROUNDS?

Student Grand Rounds (SGR), is a **peer-led education initiative** that aims to equip students with the knowledge and skills required for clinical practice. The SGR curriculum consists of peer-led sessions (**45 minutes – 60 minutes**) that aim to improve existing knowledge/skills, increase clinical exposure and build confidence. SGR facilitators will be expected to:

- Prepare and present a case from clinical practice during their time in Broken Hill.
- Focus on / develop particular teaching points which are embedded in your case.
- Facilitate discussion around your case with attendees.
