Extended Nursing Placement Program (ENPP) FAQs

- **What do I need to consider before I apply for this program?** Please consider whether you have any family, academic, or economic obligations that could impact your ability to successfully undertake this extended placement.
- **Is there an application process for this program?** Students interested in applying will need to: (1) express an interest to participate to their own university academics (2) follow their universities' procedure for placement (3) participate in a formal interview.
- **How do I get there?** You can catch a bus, train or fly to Broken Hill. However, it's recommended that you or your peers arrange to bring a vehicle with you. Public transport is limited in Broken Hill and in the other remote locations.
- **Where can I stay?** Free student accommodation will be provided as part of the ENPP in both your primary and remote host sites. This accommodation is managed by the BHUDRH.
- **Are there any fees associated with this program?** Students participating in this program will be charged a small placement coordination fee of \$25 a week. However, home universities can elect to pay this fee on behalf of their students.
- **Are there any financial assistance to support me?** A scholarship is available. \$7000 is provided by NSW Nursing and Midwifery Office, Ministry of Health and there is an opportunity to apply for an additional \$1000.



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- **Can my family, partner, friends or pets come and stay with me in the student accommodation?** No, You will be sharing this accommodation with other students. Families, partners and friends are asked to find alternative accommodation if they wish to visit you whilst you are on placement.
- **Will I meet the other successful students before the placement starts?** Yes, there will be two facilitated meetings where the students who have been selected to participate in the ENPP will get to meet each other. This is a fantastic opportunity to chat, ask questions and get ready for placement.
- **Do I need to complete a cultural awareness module?** Yes, it's compulsory to complete the online cultural awareness module before arriving for orientation. This is a requirement of all students undertaking placement in Far West NSW.
- **What happens if something goes wrong while I am on placement?** A host site contact and student program coordinators will be available to you if you experience any clinical, professional, family, relationship, or social challenges whilst participating in the program.
